

AMENDED JOINT LOCAL CIVIL RULES OF THE FAYETTE CIRCUIT COURT AND FAYETTE SUPERIOR COURT

The Courts pursuant to Administrative Rule 1 now amend the Joint Civil Rule 4 of the Fayette Circuit and Superior Courts, to be and remain in full force and effect on and at all times after January 1, 2008, and until further order of the Court.

It is further ordered that these rules be spread of record on the Record of Judgments and Order Books of the Courts and that they be printed and distributed to members of the Fayette County Bar, and two copies thereof transmitted to the Clerk of the Indiana Supreme Court and the Indiana Court of Appeals.

All cases with a designation of IF, OV, PO, SC, ~~and MF and GU~~ shall be filed in Superior Court. ~~Cases with a designation of CC shall be shared by the Circuit Court and the Superior Court subject to the following limitation: a maximum of 150 CC cases per year may be filed in the Circuit Court. Once the maximum number of CC case filings in Circuit Court has occurred, all cases with a CC designation shall be filed in the Superior Court.~~
