

The Common Council of the City of Connersville held their regular meeting on Monday, May 6, 2024, at 7:00 P.M. in the Council Chambers at City Hall.

Councilwoman Phillips led the Pledge of Allegiance before the start of the meeting.

Mayor Chad Frank presided and called the meeting to order with Councilwoman Sharon McQueen, Councilman Tommy Lee Williams Jr., Councilwoman Diana Phillips, Councilman Brian Robb, Councilman Bill Gray, and Councilman Jabin Collins were present. Attorney Geoff Wesling was also present. Councilwoman Jenny Barrett was absent.

Councilman Gray made a motion to approve the minutes of the April 15, 2024, regular meeting, April 16, 2024, joint meeting and April 25, 2024, Budget Town Hall; Councilman Rob seconded the motion. All Council members voted "yes."

Mayor Frank presented **Pending Ordinance 3940**, an ordinance amending the bargaining DOT/MVH salaries, and **Pending Ordinance 3941**, an ordinance amending the bargaining Park salaries. The tier system was dissolved with a MOU during the Board of Public Works meeting earlier today. Councilwoman Phillips made the motion to approve **Pending Ordinance 3940 and 3941** on first reading, Councilman Robb seconded the motion. All Council members voted "yes".

Councilman Robb made the motion to suspend the Rules on **Pending Ordinance 3940 and 3941** and move on to Third and Final Reading; Councilman Williams Jr. seconded the motion. All Council members voted "yes."


Councilman Gray made the motion to approve **Pending Ordinance 3940 and 3941**; on Third and Final Reading; Councilwoman Phillips seconded the motion. All Council members voted "yes."

Clerk Treasurer Rosemary Brown requested approval of **Resolution 2024-17**, a resolution to reimburse Ninety-Nine and 99/100 dollars (\$99.99) into City Hall 324 Telephone, **Resolution 2024-18**, a resolution to reimburse One Hundred Ninety-Nine and 99/100 dollars (\$199.99) into Police 324 Telephone, **Resolution 2024-19**, a resolution to reimburse One Hundred Fifty and 00/100 dollars (\$150.00) into DOT 234 Vehicle Repair, **Resolution 2024-20**, a resolution to reimburse Sixty-Five and 00/100 dollars (\$65.00) into City Hall 324 Telephone, **Resolution 2024-21**, a resolution to reimburse Fifteen and 00/100 dollars (\$15.00) into Cable 324 Telephone, and **Resolution 2024-22**, a resolution to reimburse Five Hundred Ninety and 00/100 dollars (\$590.00) into Police 324 Telephone. Councilwoman Phillips made the motion to approve **Resolution 2024-17, -18, -19, -20, -21 and -22**, Councilman Robb seconded the motion. All Councilmembers voted "yes".



Councilman Gray made the motion to approve **Resolution 2024-23**, Councilwoman Phillips seconded the motion. All Councilmembers voted "yes".
